Congratulations! We are proud of you for doing all that it takes to commit to taking an AP exam. At the bottom of the page you will find the 2017 AP Exam calendar. Additionally, please reference the AP Student Bulletin for more details.

- **Testing begins Monday, May 1, 2017 and runs through Friday, May 12, 2017 at SMHS**
- **Registration will occur from January 27, 2017 - February 27, 2017 (no late payments will be accepted)**
- **AP exams cost \$98 each**
 - Students who are eligible for the *Free/Reduced Lunch Program* pay \$5 for each exam (students who have not yet applied for the *Free/Reduced Lunch Program*, please contact Ms. Hickey in the Health Office).
 - If you have a significant financial hardship and have applied, but do not qualify for the *Free/Reduced Lunch Program*, please see Mr. Boise directly by Friday, February 4th.
 - Registration and payment will occur through Total Registration, using the web link below. No refunds will be provided to students after February 27, 2017.

What to bring?

- ✓ Photo ID (school or government issued)
- ✓ Student Pack (with AP Number)
- ✓ Sharpened #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils)
- ✓ Black or blue pens
- ✓ Approved calculator/batteries, when allowable (see AP Student Bulletin)
- ✓ Optional: Sweatshirt, bottled water (clear bottle), and/or snack (for break time)

What NOT to bring?

- x Purses, backpacks, or bags (not allowed in testing rooms)
- x Cell phones or any other electronics (not allowed in any circumstance)
- x Hat or beanie
- x Colored pencils, highlighters, correction fluid, or non-transparent pencil boxes/bags
- x Books, compass, dictionaries, notebook(s), or scratch paper

Additional Notes

- Snack and water are allowed this year, but must be kept aside and only accessed during the break
- Students must remain in testing room for the duration of the exam
- You must attend all classes prior to and/or after your AP Exam
- Bring lunch in case your test runs into the *Lunch* period (you'll need to go directly to your next class)
- NO student(s) will be admitted to the testing room, once the exam has begun
- There will be a **Pre-Identification Assembly during Tutorial on Friday, April 21st** (all students taking an AP Exam are required to attend)
- A maximum of 16 students will be allowed to sign up for the AP Chinese Exam (first come, first served)
- Contact Mr. Boise directly if any of your exam times conflict directly with one another exam, so an alternative can be arranged
